Yet still one thing remains the same, as sure by sea there's sand

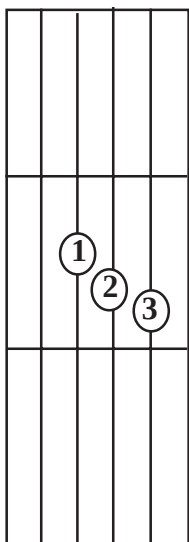
